Accessibility

- The Waldorf Beer Hall has an accessible entrance on Freeman Avenue and an interior ramp to the dining area
- The outdoor patio area is hard-packed dirt and mulch



- There is a wheelchair-accessible restroom, and the stage will be ramped
- ASL interpretation and CART captioning will be provided
- Braille materials and an audible visual description will be provided
- Masking is encouraged, and masks will be provided
- Access Ushers will be available to provide support to guests who need assistance
- Signage will be posted to direct guests to the party and restrooms
